



Urban Pathways K-5 College Charter School PowerSchool Parent Portal Questions and Answers

Q: What is the PowerSchool Parent Portal?

A: The parent portal is an online portal accessible anywhere on the web that parents can log in to and see all of their children in one place, their grades, assignments, scores, and attendance.

Q: How do I log into PowerSchool? How can I find my account information?

A: PowerSchool logins are granted by the school. We will verify your identity before giving you an account to help protect student data and privacy. From there, you can log into your school's respective portal.

You will need the:

To log in for the first time:

1. Access the Parent or Student Portal. <https://urbanpathwaysk5.powerschool.com/public/home.html>
2. Create an Account. Once in the Student and Parent Portal, you will need to create an account. Be sure to store your username and password in a secure manner.
3. Add your students. Use the Access ID for each of your students to link them to your account. Again, please contact rlucas@upcsk5.net for your Access ID and Password.

A: The PowerSchool Mobile App gives parents and students instant access to information they need to stay up-to-date on student grades, performance, and attendance.

- Receive real-time push notifications with updates about grades, scores, attendance, assignments, and teacher comments.
- Access all of your children in one portal
- View grades, assignments, attendance, and more
- Designed for iPhones/iOS, tablets, and Google/Android devices
